Recognise and celebrate their strengths and achievements

How they grow and will change as they become older-Use of key words: vagina. Term used in description of how a baby grows inside a mummy's tummy and born either through the vagina or through a special operation called caesarean section

Recognise different types of teasing and bullying and that these are wrong

Identify ways in which people and families are unique

Judge what kind of physical contact is acceptable, comfortable and uncomfortable and how to respond

Know the difference between secrets and surprises

Year 3

Self esteem

Changes to theirs body and personal care Use of key words: penis, vulva, hygiene

Attributes of a positive healthy relationship

Challenging gender stereotypes

Protection from unwanted touch- Use of key words: penis, testicles, vulva, vagina and includes pictorial

representation

Asking for help

Year 4

Responding to emotions

Changes to their body, understanding changes related to puberty. Use of key words: foetus, puberty.

Behaviours which are acceptable and unacceptable.

Differences between people, including identity and family.

Marriage is a decision to be entered into freely.

How to manage a situation

Year 5

Changing emotions through puberty

Body changes through puberty- Use of key words: puberty, penis, erection, wet dream, vagina, vaginal discharge, periods

How to maintain healthy relationships

Correct terms associated with gender identity-Use of key words: sex, intersex, transgender, gay, lesbian Online safety

Exposure to explicit images online and how to deal with it

Year 6

Images in the media

Sexual intercourse- Use of key words: sexual intercourse, conception

Nature and consequences of discrimination- Use of key words: homophobic, biphobic, transphobic Cultural practices which are against British law- Use of key words: vulva, clitoris, circumcision, female genital mutilation

Infections can be shared during sexual intercourse- Use of key words: Infection, sexually transmitted infection, condom
